Scholarship Selection Guidelines

Scholarships will be awarded using the following steps:

- The scholarship with the **highest dollar amount** will be considered first.
- The scholarship will be awarded to the applicant with the highest score who has applied for and meets all the criteria of the scholarship under consideration.
- In accordance with Foundation policy the winner of the scholarship will be removed from consideration for any future Foundation Awards.

The process will begin again with the scholarship with the next highest dollar amount and will continue until all scholarships are awarded.

In addition:

1. Applicants must meet the criteria for scholarship, as demonstrated by what the applicant has written in the application and essay(s), in order to be considered for a scholarship.
2. The applicant must have applied for the scholarship.
3. Scholarships with extra essay requirement are chosen based on the quality of the extra essay, assuming all other scholarship criteria have been met.
4. Scholarships for which there is no qualified applicant will not be awarded.
